Two-dimensional art, such as computer graphics, paintings, photography, and drawings, is also acceptable and must be matted. There are no restrictions in regard to media size or dimensions.

THEME: No restrictions. However, artwork that in some way reflects the event theme, "Visions for Hope," is preferred.

SELECTION: Hope Alive will try to display all works submitted. Due to limited space, this may not be possible. Hope Alive reserves the right to determine which artwork will be included in the silent auction. Hope Alive is not responsible for lost or damaged artwork.

BEST OF SHOW: By attendees' votes, one artwork will receive a Best of Show award. All donated artwork is the property of Hope Alive.

FEES: There are NO fees to participate.

ADMISSION: Hope Alive's "Visions for Hope" fundraiser is open to the general public. Each student artist will receive one free ticket. Additional tickets for admission will be available for \$25 at the door.
